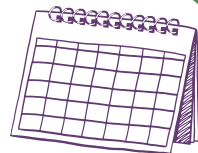

We have lots of ideas for school events coming up this year which we can't wait to share with you all."

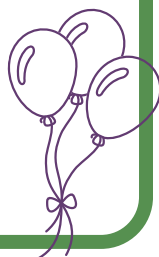
