We look forward to seeing you there and chatting to you over a hot drink and cake!

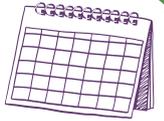
FSM Application

Whilst all children in Reception Class, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to receive a free school meal under the Universal Free School Meal entitlement, parents and carers are strongly encouraged to also complete a free school meal application form as each child eligible for a Free School Meal based attracts a 'Pupil Premium' for the School which is provided by Central Government and equates to a cash amount for your child's School.
