Family Event

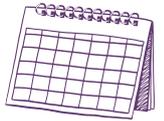


