We wish him all the very best as he returns to another of our Trust schools. **Thank you, Mr Owen - you will be greatly missed!**



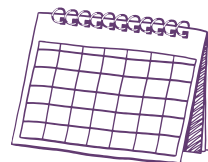
## Well done, Y6!
